



"EAGLE OVERVIEW" The Eagles have landed.

he United States Women's National Rugby team has returned to the British Isles to defend their World Cup Championship title against teams from 11 formidable rugby countries.

From the top, there is no where to go but down, so it is with great excitement and some trepidation that the Eagles take to the soft Scottish sod to reclaim the glory of their inaugural Women's World Cup victory.

To win the second-ever Women's Cup would literally be unprec-

edented, but win or lose, this amalgamation of Americans have already become the vanguard of women's rugby. With no national financial sponsorship and scant commercial support, this group has not only made it to this top international event, they are the standardbearers of their sport.

These women come virtually from every walk of life. Most are in their 30's, with full-time professions and responsibilities. A few are still in school, balancing their educational endeavors with the demands of world-class athletic training and the development of a well-rounded life. These athletes may hold truest to the requisite of rugby played as amateur sport, as they actually pay for the privilege to play.

In that spirit of sportsmanship, and braving the knowledge that every other team at the event wants to beat the U.S., first year Head Coach Franck Boivert said that no matter how the team places, his goal for the Eagles is to enjoy their moments here.

"We will not feel any particular pressure as defending world champions," Boivert said in March. "If the team is having fun, they will play well, and the rest will fall into place."

Pooled with Sweden and Japan, these matches may offer some of the best wide-open, attackstyled rugby the U.S. women have to offer. Losing to England in the June, 1993 Can-Am matches have set the stage for a hotly contested re-match, and with the New Zealanders out of the picture, the U.S. may already be looking ahead.

"Playing in the Can-Am matches was the most fun I've ever had playing rugby," said Eagle winger Patty Jervey, the highest-capped U.S. player. "I'm looking forward to these matches because I feel like our backs are going to be able to use our speed and skills to the utmost, whereas in the first World Cup, we mainly chased kicks."

Other than ensuring his Eagles have fun, Boivert said he wants to play the kind of rugby that all fans can appreciate, not just a particular team's supporters.

Admitting there is still much apprehension within the international rugby community over women playing rugby, especially at the World Cup level, Boivert said he wants his team to continue to earn respect.

"We are the champions, so really the next goal is to play very attractive rugby—rugby that everyone likes to play and watch," Boivert said.

After a successful playing and coaching career in France, Boivert moved to the U.S. and began his women's rugby coaching career in 1981. In just over one year, he transformed a young collegiate side at UCLA into a national contender at the 1982 U.S. Club Championships. After a three-year stint with the Bruins, Boivert was named Head Coach of the Pacific Coast RFU Team. The Grizzlies achieved international acclaim in 1989, when Boivert took them on a successful tour to New Zealand. In recognition of his prowess to develop a team to its potential, Boivert was named Eagle coach in June 1993.




